This workshop has a fire theme as we approach the darker nights of winter and the festivities of Bonfire Night. Back again this November, Dawn from Kettler's Cottage Crafts will show us how to make several types of candles in this popular workshop including scented soy wax and beautiful beeswax candles, then use gift wrap to turn your special candles into perfect presents.

Dawn is committed to providing products that are as natural and environmentally-friendly as possible and sources ingredients locally. Soy candles are made from a type of soybean oil and are a very good alternative to paraffin candles – the wax comes from a natural renewable source and is not made from petroleum (like paraffin candles) and burning of soy candles does not increase the CO<sub>2</sub> level in the atmosphere. Beeswax candles are also a great alternative to paraffin candles – they are brighter, last longer, smell like honey, do not produce smoke or soot and, of course they are sourced naturally from bees.
