Feltmaking is a traditional craft based on very simple, age-old techniques which can be used to produce a wide range of unique items. Sue from Hawkmoon Crafts was originally inspired by the sea and now makes felt pictures framed with driftwood collected along the Humber. She also makes jewellery, felt flowers and other items. In this workshop Sue will introduce you to the various techniques and fibres used in the feltmaking process, look at a range of handmade felt items and learn the basic principles of this traditional craft. Using merino wool, which comes in beautiful, vibrant colours, you will, in the morning, create a fabulous flower which will not wilt or fade! Then in the afternoon session you will design and make a set of unique hand-rolled spiral beads with which to make a stunning and original piece of jewellery.
