Sowing Seeds for Spring: Planning and Sowing a Cutting Garden.

This 1-day workshop will be taught by Rachel Petheram who runs the Cutting Garden at Doddington Hall, north of Lincoln, and whose flowers are sold in the wonderful Farm shop there. Rachel is "passionate about natural seasonal flowers and about producing flowers in a sustainable way" – she grows all her flowers without using harmful pesticides or chemicals and you can do the same in your garden too.
