Sunday 25th October - 'Hand-made Papermaking'

Use re-cycled paper, flowers, herbs and natural dyes to create beautiful paper. 9.30am to 5.30pm. £50, includes materials and lunch. Max 6

Course Description

Papermaking is a popular course for adults as the process is quite simple but the applications are endless. Using papermaking frames and a food liquidiser, everyone learns to make their own sheets of hand made paper from recycled paper pulp. Participants learn how to prepare their own raw materials, form their paper, press it, and process it for drying. By adding different colours of recycled papers, as well as flowers, herbs, organic and other materials, every new piece of hand made paper that gets made is different from the one before. We will be gathering plants which grow in the Manor House gardens, as well as those grown by the artist, to make papers which will be both seasonal and very special. You'll also learn about natural dyes and fibres which can be incorporated into paper, and how to embed leaves, petals and seed head. Finished pieces can then be used for writing, drawing or painting. Hand made paper can also be made into greeting cards, printed on or used as mounting card for pictures and paintings.

Run by artist Jonathan Kerejko from Timberland, this course will run for the full day. Lovely home-made food will be served at lunchtime along with Apple Wine made from apples from our garden. All materials will be provided but please bring along a pencil, rubber and pair of scissors. Wear old clothing or a good work shirt or apron (the natural dyes can stain clothing) and rubber gloves if skin is sensitive.
