
## **Private Alick WARE**



Born at Martin on 9 May 1896 Alick was the eldest son of Samuel and Martha Ware. After leaving school he worked as a porter for the Great Northern Railway (GNR) at Thurlby near Bourne, Southery and latterly at Grimsby where he enlisted into the 10<sup>th</sup> Battalion Lincolnshire Regiment (Grimsby Chums).

During the opening attack against strongly defended German positions at Roeux near Arras on the 28 April

1917 his Battalion sustained more than four-hundred and fifty casualties. Alick was one of those killed in the attack and was just 20 years of age. He is buried at Point du Jour Military Cemetery.
